

Stovall Lake

LOCATION: In Coahoma County, 7 miles northwest of Clarksdale, MS.

SIZE: 1,200 acres.

DEPTH: Varies with the Mississippi River.

AQUATIC VEGETATION: None.

MAJOR SPORTFISH: Largemouth bass, crappie, bream (bluegill), channel catfish.

OTHER FISH: Bowfin, buffalo, common carp, drum, flathead catfish, green sunfish, gar, white bass.

FISH FORAGE: Shad, silversides, minnows, sunfish.

VISIBLE COVER: Willow trees, swamp privet.

BOTTOM FEATURES: Submerged trees, stumps, logs.

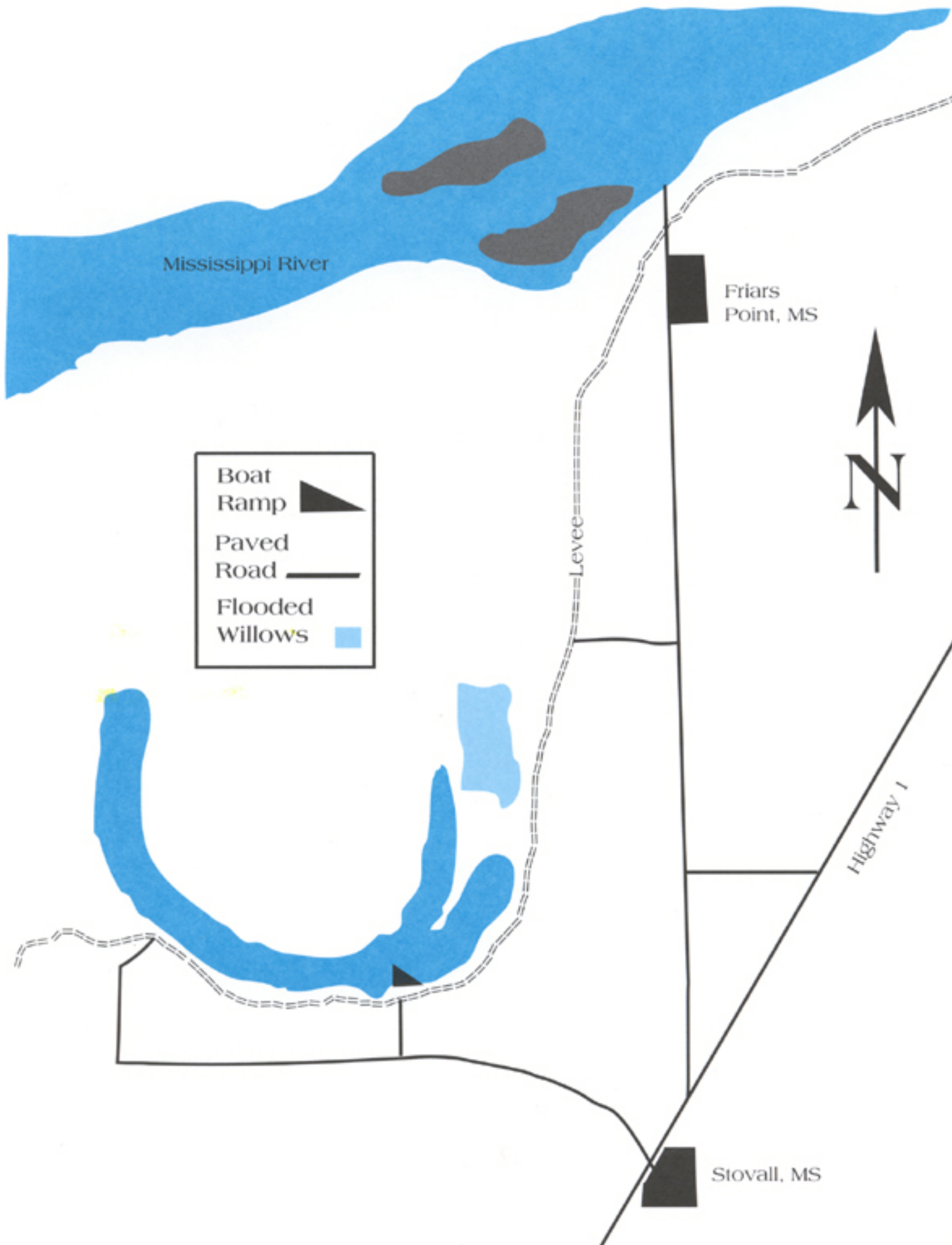


MAN-MADE FISH STRUCTURES: None
